Humber Pre-Qualification Scheme

- Known as PreQual and is a basic Pre-Qualification Scheme currently sponsored by 4 of the regions Major Clients namely, BP Chemicals, ConocoPhillips, Novartis Grimsby and Total LOR; operates as part of the Impress project.
 - Established November 2007 as a pilot scheme.
 - Impress leads the operational scheme.
 - Each Client provides a strategic manager and an operational review team member for regular contact with Impress and to measure progress against a nominations list for each Client.
 - Clients' strategic team meets annually.
 - Clients' operational team meets 4 monthly to check reports & review progress.

Humber Bank Contractor Competency Forum (HBCCF)

- Established in September 2000.
- Known as ConCom; operates as part of the Impress project.
- Meets monthly to manage a Contractor Auditing Scheme based on systems competency.
 - A Chairperson is elected periodically (typically 1 -2 years in post) from the Client member group; current Chairperson Paul Sheriff, Cristal Global (Millennium).
 - Contractors are welcome to attend by application to the Chairperson.
 - CATCH provides resources to the Forum. Dave Roulson is the key contact for Impress. Lesley Pickard provides secretariat services and a supporting role on finance and credit control.

Humber Engineering Managers' Forum (HEMF)

- Meets quarterly and is attended by Senior Engineering Managers from Humber Bank Major Clients and their invited Contractors.
